



"Vesper Doily"

Designed by HAZEL

Finished size: 6 1/2" in diameter

MATERIALS:

crochet cotton thread (size 10)

steel crochet hook 1.5mm

Also available another size of thread and hook as you like or think proper.

STITCH GUIDE

3 DTR-CLUSTER

* Yo 3 times, insert hook in sp indicated, Yo and pull up a loop, (Yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times; repeat from * 2 times more, Yo and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

BPSC (back post single crochet)

insert hook from back to front around post of st indicated, work sc.

3 TR-CLUSTER

* Yo twice, insert hook in st indicated, Yo and pull up a loop, (Yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice; repeat from * 2 times more, Yo and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

3 DC-CLUSTER

(Yo, insert hook in sp indicated, Yo and pull up a loop, Yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3times, Yo and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

PICOT

ch3, sl st in the top of same sc just made.

LARGE CROSS



① Yo 5 times.



② insert hook in next ch4 sp.



③ Yo and pull up a loop, (Yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.



④ Yo twice.



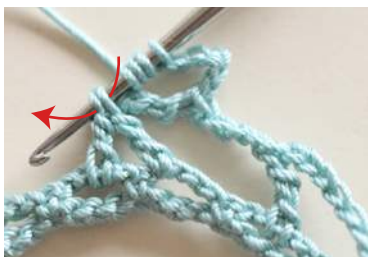
⑤ insert hook in next ch4-sp, Yo and pull up a loop, (Yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.
(That making 2tr-decreasing.)



⑥ (Yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times.



⑦ ch5, and Yo 3 times.



⑧ insert hook in the top of 2tr-decreasing point that made at ⑤.



⑨ Yo and pull up a loop, (Yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times.

Rnd1: ch5, join with sl st to form a ring.

Rnd2: ch1, (sc in ring, ch3)8 times, sl st in first sc for join.

Rnd3: (sl st in next ch-3 sp, ch5, 3 dtr-cluster, ch5,sl st in same ch-3 sp)8 times, sl st in first st for join.

Rnd4: working backyard of petals, ch2, bpsc in second dtr in previous rnd (second dtr = center dtr of 3-dtr cluster), (ch3, bpsc in center dtr of next dtr-cluster)around, ch1, hdc in first sc to form last ch-3 sp.

Rnd5: ch7, (sc in top of 3dtr-cluster, ch3,tr in ch3 sp in Rnd4, ch3) around, sl st to 4th ch of beginning ch-7.

Rnd6: ch3, 2tr-cluster in same stitch (that makes beginning 3tr-cluster), (ch5, sc in next sc, ch5, 3tr-cluster in next tr, ch5) around, ch1, tr in the top of begining 3tr-cluster to form last ch5 sp.

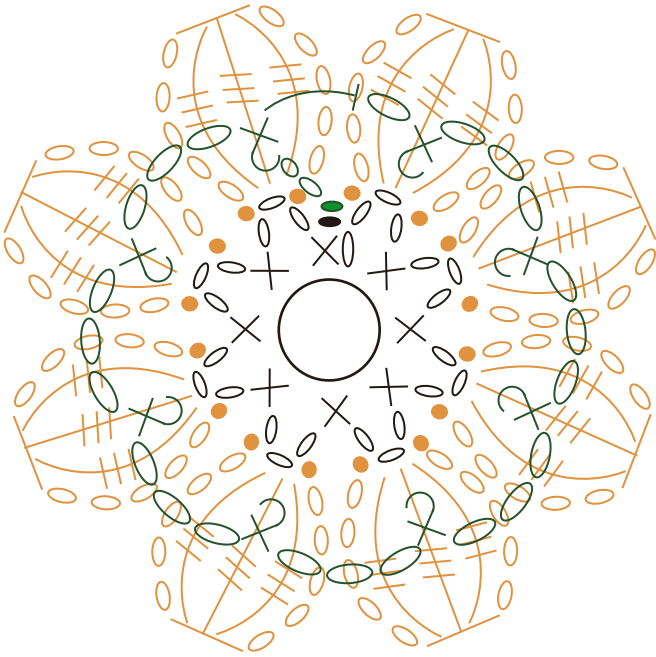
Rnd7: ch1, sc in same sp, ch13, (2sc in next ch5-sp, sc in next sc,2sc in next sp, ch13) 7times, 2sc in next sp, sc in next sc, sc in nextsp, join with sl st to beginning sc.


Rnd8: sl st in next ch-13 sp, ch3, 2dc-cluster that made beginning 3dc-cluster, (ch3, 3dc-cluster in same ch13-sp) 6 times, *[3dc cluster, (ch3,3dc-cluster) 6 times in next ch13-sp] repeat* 7 times, join with sl st to the top of beginning 3dc-cluster.

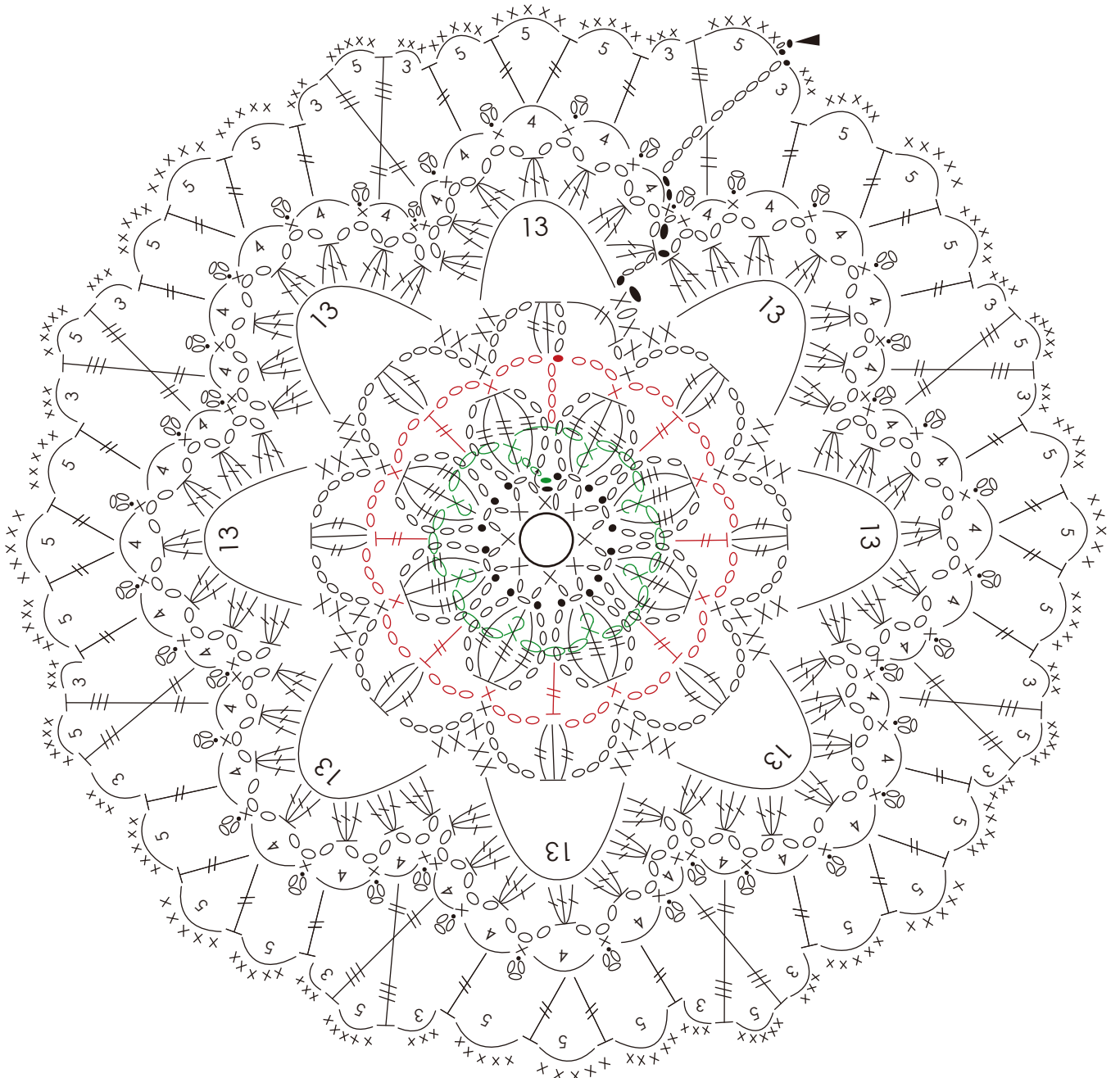
Rnd9: sl st in next ch-3 sp, ch1, sc in same sp, ch4, *[(sc in next sp, working picot, ch4) 4 times, sc in next sp, PICOT, sc in next sp, ch4,] repeat* around, sc in next sp, PICOT, join with sl st to sc beginning.

Rnd10: sl st in next 2 stitches of ch4 sp, ch4, tr in the last ch4-sp of previous rnd (keep Right Side; do not turn), ch11, dtr in top of tr just made(that makes beginning large cross), *[ch3, skip beginning sp and next picot, tr in next ch4-sp, ch5, (tr, ch5,tr) in next ch4-sp, ch5, tr in next sp, ch3, working LARGE CROSS by using next 2 spaces], repeat* 7 times, ch3, tr in next ch4-sp, ch5, (tr, ch5,tr) in next ch4-sp, ch5, tr in next sp, ch3, sl st to 6th ch of beginning ch-11.

Rnd11: sl st in next ch5 sp, ch1, *[5sc in same sp, skip next st, 3sc in next sp,(skip next st, 5sc in next sp) 3 times, skip next st, 3sc in next sp], repeat* around, join with slip st to first sc, finish off.

How to adding SPOTS on petals

You can arrange extra-colored spots on petals.

cut off the thread at the end of Rnd3, starting with another color thread in Rnd 4.

after ending Rnd4, join and start working with base color again.
